















## 2018 BYOx Core App list – Years 3 to 6

The core apps are required as a condition of bringing iPads to school as part of the BYOx Program and must be installed on all students' Personally Owned iPads. We have selected free apps as our core list, with the paid apps being requested by classes who intend to use them. The core apps are used more frequently at our school and often will be used across many year levels. Other extra apps may be required, depending on the year level and will be sent home as part of the Parent Term Newsletter. Please refer to the school website for more information.

Students who have been part of the BYOx program in previous years and purchased paid apps will still have opportunity to use them.

<b>Investigating, Creating, Communicating Apps</b>		
Microsoft Word	 *Free while enrolled at a QLD State School (using the student school email address)	Create and edit word documents that can be used on other devices and laptops.
Microsoft Excel		Create and edit spreadsheets that can be used on other devices and laptops.
Microsoft PowerPoint		Create and edit presentations that can be used on other devices and laptops.
iMovie	 Free with new iPads bought after Sept 2013	Create beautiful HD movies and movie trailers.
Doceri	 Free (with watermark)	A whiteboard where students can record their work and save as a movie.
Book Creator	 \$7.99	Create multimodal books with text, audio, images and videos. Save and share books with iBooks for future reference.
Doodle Buddy	 Free	Draw pictures, import photos- use to add to posters in Pages, or when making your own books, annotating documents/pictures.
Garage Band	 Free with new iPads bought after Sept 13	Create music with a range of instruments. Students could set spelling, sight words and maths facts to music to enhance learning, or compose their own original music for other applications.
Pages	 Free with new iPads bought after Sept 13	Main document producing app – has templates for everything- posters, resumes, letters- can be emailed directly from within app.
i-nigma	 Free	Turns your camera into a sophisticated barcode reader. Exceptional quick scanning.
<b>Apps that promote Literacy and Numeracy</b>		
Mathletics Student	 Free	Numeracy. The school has a subscription to this service. All students have a login. Mathletics is used as part of our school numeracy program and may be part of student homework.
Math Learning Centre Apps	 Free (Each app has to be downloaded separately)	Number Line, Pattern Shapes, Number Frames, Number Rack, Geoboards, Number Pieces, Number Pieces Basic, Math Vocabulary Cards A set of manipulative apps that help students visualise and explain different aspects of Mathematics
